Introduction to Program Objectives

3 to 6 Years old

Points and lines

- Discover the power of points and lines as the basic language
- Discover the narrative possibilities of points and lines and create a mini story.
- Get to know the work of the artist *Yayoi Kusama*
- Discover the artistic possibilities of points and lines as plastic resources and deepen the skills of artistic expression.



Collage



- Introduce the collage technique and English artwork vocabulary through hands-on activities
- Spark curiosity about the artist Henri Matisse by observing and appreciating some of his collage works.
- Observe the textures of different elements, objects, and materials
- Identify the colors that we associate with the jungle and make a Wild Picture using the collage

Pointillism

- Identify and experience different possibilities of the point while introducing the pictorial technique: pointillism.
- Work with first and secondary colors to experiment with the mixture of colors using the pointillism technique.
- Use observation of the technique and colors to awaken curiosity and imagination.



Introduction to Program Objectives


7 to 11 Years old

Cubism

- Promote knowledge and observation of the geometric shapes in our environment.
- Introduce the concept of cubism artwork and discover the *Three Musicians* cubist work by Picasso.
- Work with observation to encourage curiosity and imagination while introducing related concepts and vocabulary in the English language
- Use games as a way to learn and apply artistic technique by making portraits with geometric figures.



The Mona Lisa



- Introduce aspects of Leonardo da Vinci's life and get to know his inventions and secret code.
- Introduce *The Mona Lisa*, remake her portrait using different artistic expressions and demonstrate the pictorial technique used by Da Vinci.
- Work with the artistic education methodologies, inspired by the works of Leonardo da Vinci.
- Enrich the visual language of the kids in English.

Fluorescent

- Introduce fluorescent art and its different manifestations.
- Promote visual language through new resources of artistic expression and related English vocabulary
- Experiment with different textures as resources including different elements, objects, and materials.
- Observe the fluorescent colors of Tanya Schultz's works.

Collage at the park- 3 to 6 Years old
